

Why Grenada?

- Grenada Citizenship Program is known to its reputability and transparency, as it has been established in 2013.
- It takes 3-6 months to be completed.
- Grenada passport is respected worldwide, and Grenada passport holders travel to 131 countries of the world (the passport is ranked 27th worldwide) without a visa or visa on arrival, including the United Kingdom, the Schengen countries and China (90 days) as well as a multiple Visa for the United Arab Emirates (180 days).
- Grenada is the only Caribbean country whose holders are able to benefit from the E-2 Treatment agreement signed with the United States that allows investors to reside and work in USA.
- Grenada has a reputable higher education, due to having one of the greatest universities around the world (Saint George's university) in many majors such as Medicine and Veterinary Medicine. Also, Grenadians can enjoy 90% discount of universities tuition fees after one year of residency in Grenada. They can also get the (Queen Elizabeth Commonwealth scholarship) for higher education in Canada and UK, which making it an ideal place for investors and their families.
- The application includes the main applicant, spouse, single child under 30 years old as well as dependent parents (main applicant and spouse's parents) in the age of 55 and above and dependent single siblings (main applicant and spouse's siblings) in the age of 18 and above and they must be added at the beginning of the application.
- Grenada's citizenship can be passed to future generations by descent (Do not stop at first generation).
- All nationalities can benefit from the Grenada program except Iran.
